



Interscholastic Equestrian Association (IEA)

Hunt Seat Program 2026-2027 (August to May)

Courtney Carlson Hunters and Jumpers will have Two (2) IEA teams who will both compete at the:

- Middle School Junior Varsity team grades 4th to 8th grade
- High School Varsity team grades 9th to 12th grade

IEA Classes will be offered in four (4) Skill Levels-Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Open

Team Requirements:

- Each rider will need to compete in a minimum of 1 regular competition up to a maximum of 5 regular competitions per season. Attendance for Region finals, zones and nationals competitions will be based on season performance.
- Each rider will be required to participate in two (2) lessons, a week-1 regular lesson and 1 group IEA lesson to ensure that all team members are prepared for the competitions.
- It is highly recommended that each rider participate in two (2) weeks of IEA summer camps, the minimum requirement is one (1) week of IEA camp.
- Each rider will need to have their own approved ATSM helmet and highly recommend that they have an air-canister vest.
- Each rider will need to be on a lesson package.
- Each rider will need to have the approved show and team apparel

Team Activities:

- Monthly meetings
- Team activities

Barn Fees:

- \$250 Annual IEA Fee due by August 1st
- \$150 IEA Coaching Fee per competition within the Columbus area
- \$250 IEA Coaching Fee, travel expenses, etc. for Region finals, zones and nationals competition
- \$75 IEA Group Lesson
